Utah Department of Corrections

UCA § 64-13-6 establishes several department duties, including:

- ★ Protect the public through institutional operations & community supervision
- ★ Collaborate and share information with other state, local, and federal law enforcement agencies
- ★ Establish case action plans to prioritize risk factors and programs

UCA § 64-13-20 presentence investigations

UCA § 64-13-21 supervision of probationers and parolees



Probation & Parole Supervision

<u>Probation</u> - Community supervision ordered by the court instead of serving time in prison. Probationers are ordered to follow certain conditions set by the court, often under the supervision of a probation officer.

<u>Parole</u> - Release from prison with certain conditions before the completion of the maximum sentence. Parolees are still considered to be serving their sentences, and may be returned to prison if they violate conditions of their parole.



Division of Adult Probation and Parole

- ★ Operational division within the Utah Department of Corrections
- ★ Five regions:
 - o Northern Utah Region: Weber, Davis, Box Elder, Cache, Rich, Morgan
 - Region 3: Salt Lake, Tooele, Summit
 - Region 4: Utah, Wasatch, Juab, Sanpete, Millard, Sevier, Piute, Garfield, Wayne west / Loa
 - Region 5: Washington, Iron, Beaver, Kane
 - Region 6: Carbon, Duchesne, Uintah, Daggett, Emery, Grand, San Juan, Wayne east / Hanksville
- ★ Five community correctional centers in Salt Lake and Weber Counties

Division of Adult Probation and Parole

- ★ Correctional officers, agents, supervisors and civilian staff
- ★ LEO certified agents
- ★ Trained in evidence-based practices for community corrections
- ★ Monitor conditions of probation and parole
- ★ Engage with offenders to address risk factors and improve opportunities for success
- ★ Report progress or violations to the Court and Board of Pardons and Parole



Other Types of Supervision in Utah

Law enforcement may encounter:

- ★ Federal United States Courts & federal prison
- ★ County local government probation & pretrial services
- ★ Private licensed by DOPL to provide probation, justice courts
- ★ Court bench probation with a judge, unsupervised

- ★ Criminal History / Bureau of Criminal Identification (BCI)
 - Utah Criminal Justice Information System (UCJIS)
 - Driver License Query includes probation/parole link (DL)
 - Corrections/Custody Information (CHQL)
 - O-Track inquiry (OTRK)
 - Agent and on-call officer contact information
 - *Information in 3rd party platforms may vary (Spillman, FATPOT)*
- ★ UDC offender search (corrections.utah.gov)
- ★ Individual self-reports being on supervision





Criminal Investigations of Supervised Offenders

AP&P can assist law enforcement with individuals we supervise:

- ★ Background information on suspects
 - Residence, employment, vehicle, associates
- ★ Locate or contact suspects
- ★ Verification of supervised conditions
 - Curfew, no contact, treatment, substance testing
- ★ Search of person or property based on supervised conditions
- ★ Detain individuals for up to 72-hours on administrative hold
 - Investigative purposes or to request arrest warrant
 - May <u>only</u> be lodged by AP&P officers



Search and Seizure of Supervised Offenders

Individuals on probation or parole with AP&P have diminished Fourth Amendment rights as to searches
State v. Velasquez, 672 P.2d 1254, 1262 (Utah 1983)

- ★ Public: LEO may search individuals only if they have a warrant, with limited exceptions
- ★ Probationer: AP&P needs to have <u>reasonable suspicion</u> to search probationer; and may designate other LEOs to perform search
- ★ Parolee: AP&P and LEO may search at any time, with or without a search warrant, and with or without cause



Search and Seizure of Supervised Offenders

Parolee searches continued:

- ★ If LEO searches <u>residence</u>, they first need to <u>inform AP&P</u>
- ★ If LEO searches <u>person</u> or affects, needs to <u>notify AP&P</u> as soon as possible after conducting the search
- ★ See Utah Code Ann. § 77-23-301

Law enforcement agencies should consult with their department counsel or prosecuting attorneys office regarding search and seizure questions



Arrests or Citations of Supervised Offenders

Agents receive automated desktop alerts when a suspect under AP&P supervision is:

- ★ Cited or arrested by a Utah law enforcement agency
- ★ Alert message includes arrest agency, date and time
 - Excludes:
 - Offense details and circumstances
 - Criminal history, employment, or DL checks
- ★ Automated alert requires positive ID match between BCI and O-Track data
- ★ Arresting agency can contact agent or on-call supervisor


