AMBER is an acronym for America's Missing: Broadcast Emergency Response

Utah adopted the AMBER plan in April of 2002

First one was issued June 05, 2002

49 AMBER Alerts







Criteria for an AMBER Alert:

Law enforcement believes it is a child abduction

17 years of age or younger 🤗

Imminent danger, serious bodily injury or death 📀



Information to assist the public in the safe recovery of the victim or apprehension of the suspect 📀





Must be able to mark YES TO ALL FOUR criteria questions in order to issue an AMBER Alert

When the agency is ready to cancel the Amber Alert you will use the UAAM transaction

Use the remarks field to update the cancellation Example: The AMBER Alert for BCI is being cancelled. Child has been located safely, thank you.

When you click the cancel button, a notification will appear at the top of the screen asking you if you are sure that you want to cancel the alert

If you have difficulty cancelling your AMBER Alert (error message or UCJIS issue) you need to contact the UCJIS Help Desk immediately and ask them to force a cancellation

Make sure you document any error you receive so there can be follow up by BCI





The abducted child should be entered into NCIC (it is not a mandatory before issuing the AMBER Alert)

CA (child abduction) should be added in the MNP field until after the AMBER Alert is issued then the MNP field should be modified to AA (The caveat will read: AMBER Alert issued for this child)



ENDANGERED MISSING ADVISORY



ENDANGERED MISSING ADVISORY

The Endangered Missing Advisory is to rapidly disseminate information about a missing and endangered person to law enforcement agencies and media

Agency may enter an Endangered Missing Advisory if the circumstances do not meet the AMBER Alert criteria



ENDANGERED MISSING ADVISORY

If the person is missing under unexplained/suspicious circumstances or may be in danger due to:

Age Health Environment Weather conditions Accompanying a dangerous person

If there is information that could assist the public in the safe recovery of the missing person

The EMA will go out to all law enforcement so you can add any and all information that they may need



BCI quality controls the EMA for sensitive information and only takes out information that the media should not have unless released by the public information officer

BCI does not remove any information that goes out to law enforcement

BCI sends the broadcast to Utah media via email if they are signed up to receive the information

The Blue Alert is developed to assist in the apprehension of violent criminals who injure local, state or federal law enforcement officers

It will inevitably hinder the violators ability to flee the state and facilitate a speedy capture, helping to eliminate the threat they would pose to law enforcement and the community

Your agency administration MUST approve this alert





What qualifies as serious bodily injury?

Utah Criminal Code 76-1-601

(11) "Serious bodily injury" means bodily injury that creates or causes serious permanent disfigurement, protracted loss or impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ, or creates a substantial risk of death.





(12) "Substantial bodily injury" means bodily injury, not amounting to serious bodily injury, that creates or causes protracted physical pain, temporary disfigurement, or temporary loss or impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ.

With the EBA transaction it will transmit an in-state broadcast, the agency must cancel same way

H.B. 215 : Creates a silver alert notification system for missing endangered adults

The bill defines endangered adult as a person 60 years of age or older with dementia or a person under 60 years of age who has a form of dementia





H.B. 215 requires that the system utilize highway signage in the geographical area where the person went missing







Silver Alert is mandatory if the circumstances fit the criteria

TOC will light up signage in the area where the victim was last seen, if law enforcement agency feels more signage is necessary they can make that request by calling UCJIS Help Desk


