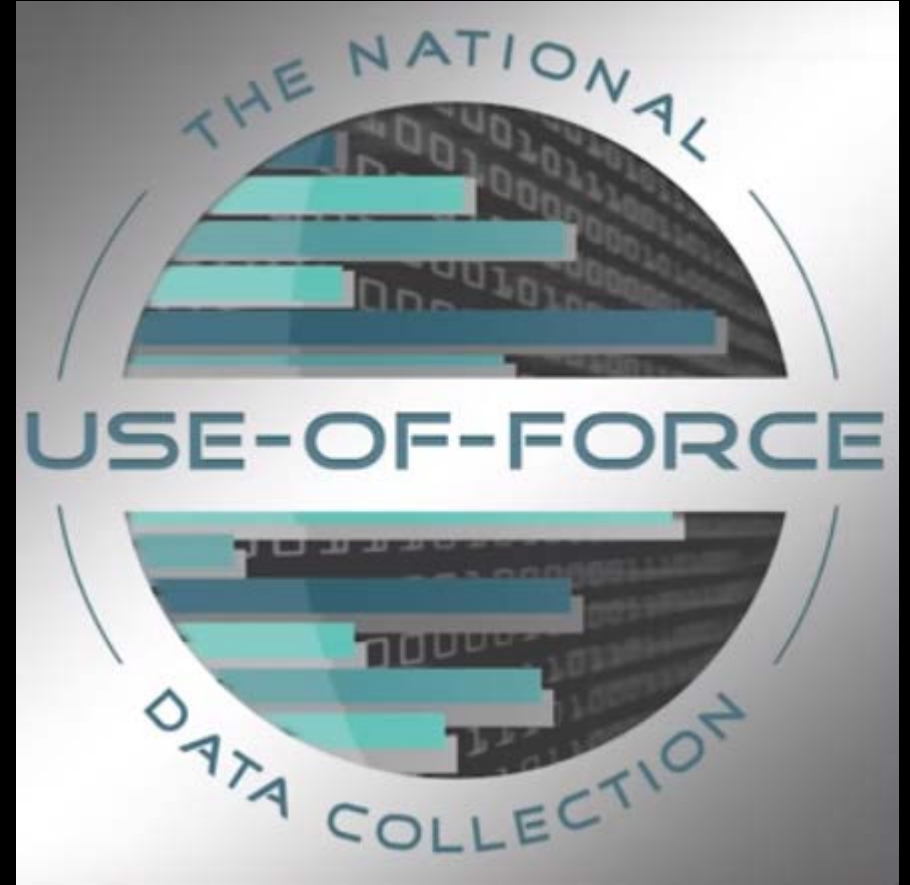




# USE OF FORCE



UTAH STATUTE **53-10-202.2(C)** MAKES  
PARTICIPATION IN  
THE COLLECTION OF USE-OF-FORCE DATA  
*REQUIRED*  
FOR ALL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES IN THE  
STATE.

Data is being collected at state  
Level through UCJIS and forwarded to the FBI quarterly.

# WHY?

- Increased awareness and questions by the public concerning use-of-force incidents
- Provide statistics that may help answer questions, measure the issue, find areas of concern, and allow for more informed conversation.
- Lack of statistical data (media driving the narrative)

# WHAT IS CONSIDERED USE OF FORCE?

## **FBI Incident Requirements for Use of Force Collection**

- When a fatality occurs connected to use of force by a law enforcement officer
- When there is serious bodily injury to a person connected to use of force by a law enforcement officer
- When a firearm is discharged by law enforcement at or in a direction of a person that did not otherwise result in death or serious bodily injury

## **Utah Specific**

*(Optional and not submitted or required by the FBI)*

- When a Taser is discharged by law enforcement at or in a direction of a person that did not otherwise result in death or serious bodily injury
- When physical force is used by law enforcement that did not result in death or serious bodily injury

# THE NATIONAL USE-OF-FORCE DATA COLLECTION WILL INCLUDE:

## Incident information:

- Date and time of the incident
- Total number of officers
- Location of the incident

## Subject information:

- (Age, sex, race, ethnicity, height, and weight)
- Impaired
- Injury type
- Type(s) of force used

## Officer Information:

- (Age, sex, race, ethnicity, height, and weight)
- Years of service
- Injury type

## UOF Entry

Do NOT report a Use of Force Incident unless at least one of the following conditions applies.

- When a fatality occurs connected to use of force by a law enforcement officer.
- When there is serious bodily injury to a person connected to use of force by a law enforcement officer.
- When a firearm is discharged by law enforcement at or in a direction of a person that did not otherwise result in death or serious bodily injury.
- (Utah specific - not submitted to the FBI) When a taser is discharged by law enforcement at or in a direction of a person that did not otherwise result in death or serious bodily injury.
- (Utah specific-not submitted to the FBI) When physical force is used by law enforcement that did not result in death or serious bodily injury. Only report this type of force when it meets at least one of the following criteria:
  1. Any canine inflicted injury
  2. Any discharge of Pepper Spray
  3. Any strike or attempted strike with an impact object
  4. Any strike or attempted strike of an individual with hands or feet
  5. Any physical contact with an individual resulting in an injury or complaint of injury that requires medical treatment or a medical release to book the individual into jail
  6. Any discharge of a Less-Lethal Weapon

The definition of serious bodily injury will be based, in part, on 18 United States Code (USC) Section 2246 (4), to mean "bodily injury that involves a substantial risk of death, unconsciousness, protracted and obvious disfigurement, or protracted loss or impairment of the function of a bodily member, organ, or mental faculty."

## Incident Location

Law enforcement agencies (LEAs) should use this data element to report the type of location/premises where the use of force took place. The FBI UCR Program recognizes that for many incidents, there is more than one possible choice for reporting a location. For the purposes of this collection, law enforcement should use their best estimate for the location of where the use of force took place. Because the geographic location of an incident is not always the same as the functional location of the incident, the FBI UCR Program relies on LEAs to report the most appropriate location type. For example, if an incident occurred at an elementary school playground during school hours, the location can be classified as School – Elementary/Secondary. But, if the incident occurred at the same physical location on a Saturday afternoon when the school was not operating and the public was allowed to use the facility for recreational purposes, LEAs would be equally correct in classifying the location as Park/Playground....

In the UCR Offenses section, you must provide a NIBRS Incident # or a Don't Know Incident # reason, but not both

You cannot select any other Resistance Type for a subject when you have selected 'PENDING' or 'UNKNOWN'

You cannot select a Proximity to Subject Code when the Shots Fired value is not 'YES' or 'ACCIDENTAL DISCHARGE'
