

# E-PROSECUTOR AND YOU

- Track and manage cases
- Report on any data entered in the system
  - Including data required by HB288
- Manage documents
- Electronic discovery
- Optional ability for law enforcement to submit cases electronically
- Electronic filing of documents with the courts (in testing)

# E-PROSECUTOR AND YOU

- Justice agencies and personnel already available or can import
- Local statutes can be added
- UPC maintains state statutes and updates them as needed
- Can search for cases in other jurisdictions by defendant name (read only)
- Name records – enter once, use multiple times in multiple cases

# E-PROSECUTOR AND YOU

- Data import not available except by separate contract with JTI
- Plan to apply for additional grants for licenses and storage
- Next grant application in early 2021 – awarded in late 2021
- Administrator manages user accounts, templates, forms and lists
- Administration Fee - \$206 per user per year (in addition to user license fee)






