

BACKGROUND

- THE FBI BEGAN LOOKING AT A USE OF FORCE DATA COLLECTION IN 2015 TO PROVIDE NATIONWIDE STATISTICS ON LAW ENFORCEMENT USE-OF-FORCE INCIDENTS
- As of January 1, 2019 participation in the Collection of use-of-force data became available for all law enforcement agencies in the state
- As of May 5^{TH} , 2021 H.B. 84 requires law enforcement agencies to report Use of Force data to BCI
- Use of Force data is collected at state level through UCJIS and forwarded to the FBI monthly

REQUIREMENTS TO REPORT

- WHEN A <u>FATALITY</u> OCCURS CONNECTED TO USE OF FORCE BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER
- WHEN THERE IS <u>SERIOUS BODILY INJURY</u> TO A PERSON CONNECTED TO USE OF FORCE BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER
- When a <u>firearm is discharged</u> by law enforcement at or in a direction of a person that did not otherwise result in death or serious bodily injury

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SERIOUS BODILY INJURY DEFINITION

SERIOUS BODILY INJURY WOULD INCLUDE ALL GUNSHOT WOUNDS (REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THEY ARE PENETRATING OR GRAZING), APPARENT BROKEN BONES, POSSIBLE INTERNAL INJURY, SEVERE LACERATION, STITCHES, SUTURES, CHIPPED TEETH, LOSS OF TEETH, CANINE BITES REQUIRING MEDICAL ATTENTION, UNCONSCIOUSNESS DUE TO AN APPLIED CAROTID ARTERY HOLD, AND INJURIES SEVERE ENOUGH TO REQUIRE MEDICAL INTERVENTION AND/OR HOSPITALIZATION. THE TERM "MEDICAL INTERVENTION" DOES NOT INCLUDE ROUTINE EVALUATION OF THE SUBJECT TO DETERMINE FITNESS FOR ARREST OR DETENTION BY AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN OR MEDICAL STAFF AT A MEDICAL FACILITY

INFORMATION COLLECTED FOR INCIDENT

- Date and time
- TOTAL NUMBER OF OFFICERS WHO APPLIED FORCE
- NUMBER OF OFFICERS FROM REPORTING AGENCY WHO APPLIED FORCE
- LOCATION TYPE (STREET, BUSINESS, HOME, ETC.)
- DID THE OFFICER(S) APPROACH THE SUBJECTS?
- Was it an ambush incident?
- Was a supervisor or senior officer consulted during the incident?
- REASON FOR INITIAL CONTACT (ROUTINE PATROL, TRAFFIC STOP, ETC.)
- IF THE INITIAL CONTACT WAS DUE TO UNLAWFUL ACTIVITY, WHAT WAS THE MOST SERIOUS OFFENSE THE INDIVIDUAL WAS SUSPECTED OF?
- IF APPLICABLE, THE REPORTING AGENCY WILL INCLUDE THE NIBRS RECORD OR LOCAL INCIDENT NUMBER OF THE REPORT DETAILING CRIMINAL INCIDENT INFORMATION ON THE SUBJECT AND/OR ASSAULT OR HOMICIDE OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.
- IF THE INCIDENT INVOLVED MULTIPLE AGENCIES, THE REPORTING AGENCY SHOULD PROVIDE CASE NUMBERS FOR THE OTHER AGENCIES' INCIDENT REPORT


INFORMATION COLLECTED FOR SUBJECT

- AGE, SEX, RACE, ETHNICITY, HEIGHT, AND WEIGHT
- INJURY/DEATH OF SUBJECT
- Type of force used
- DID THE SUBJECT DIRECT A THREAT TO THE OFFICER OR ANOTHER PERSON?
- DID THE SUBJECT RESIST?
- TYPES OF RESISTANCE OR WEAPON INVOLVEMENT (THREATS, ACTIVE AGGRESSION, FIREARMS, ETC.)
- DID THE SUBJECT HAVE A KNOWN OR APPARENT IMPAIRMENT, SUCH AS MENTAL HEALTH CONDITION OR BEING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS OR ALCOHOL?
- Was the subject believed to have a weapon?

INFORMATION COLLECTED FOR OFFICER

- AGE, SEX, RACE, ETHNICITY, HEIGHT, AND WEIGHT
- YEARS OF SERVICE IN LAW ENFORCEMENT
- Was the officer a full-time employee?
- Was the officer on duty?
- DID THE OFFICER DISCHARGE A FIREARM?
- Was the officer injured?
- IF SO, WHAT WAS THE OFFICER'S INJURY TYPE?

Incident Requirements

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Do NOT report a Use of Force Incident unless at least one of the following conditions applies.

- When a fatality occurs connected to use of force by a law enforcement officer.
- When there is serious bodily injury to a person connected to use of force by a law enforcement officer.
- When a firearm is discharged by law enforcement at or in a direction of a person that did not otherwise result in death or serious bodily injury.


The definition of serious bodily injury will be based, in part, upon Title 18 United States Code (U.S.C), Section 2246 (4): The term serious bodily injury means bodily injury that involves a substantial risk of death, unconsciousness, protracted and obvious disfigurement, or protracted loss or impairment of the function of a bodily member, organ, or mental faculty. Serious bodily injury would include all gunshot wounds (regardless of whether they are penetrating or grazing), apparent broken bones, possible internal injury, severe laceration, stitches, sutures, chipped teeth, loss of teeth, canine bites requiring medical attention, unconsciousness due to an applied carotid artery hold, and injuries severe enough to require medical intervention and/or hospitalization. The term "medical intervention" does not include routine evaluation of the subject to determine fitness for arrest or detention by an emergency medical technician or medical staff at a medical facility.






Use of Force Query gives you three options on how to edit, print, or delete any incident that was entered






- Use of Force entry allows for modification at anytime
- AS PARTICIPATION IN USE OF FORCE INCREASES WE WILL BEGIN TO START DOING MONTHLY VALIDATIONS
- PARTICIPATION IS PUBLISHED IN THE FBI'S CRIME DATA EXPLORER WEBSITE AND SIMILARLY BCI IS WORKING ON PUBLISHING A CRIME STATISTIC DASHBOARD THAT COULD INCLUDE USE OF FORCE AND WILL BE MADE PUBLIC.

RIOTS

- EACH LOCATION IS REPORTED AS ITS OWN INCIDENT
- ONLY COUNT THE ACTUAL SUBJECTS THAT FORCE WAS USED ON
- ONLY REPORT THE OFFICERS THAT APPLIED THE FORCE
- FOR FIREARM DISCHARGE, PLEASE REMEMBER THAT FIREARMS DISCHARGED AT OR IN THE DIRECTION OF A PERSON WITH LESS LETHAL MUNITIONS, SUCH AS BEANBAGS, PEPPER BALLS, AND RUBBER BULLETS ARE EXCLUDED



LET TRANSACTION

- LET IS A UCJIS TRANSACTION THAT IS REQUIRED FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT UNDER UTAH CODE 77-7-8.5
- LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES THROUGHOUT THE STATE UTILIZE THE UCJIS-LET SITE TO REPORT TACTICAL GROUP DEPLOYMENTS AND FORCIBLE ENTRY INCIDENTS AS THEY OCCUR THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. A REPORTABLE INCIDENT FOR LET IS DEFINED AS:
 - ANYTIME A FORCIBLE ENTRY IS MADE WHILE SERVING A WARRANT OR
 - ANYTIME A "TACTICAL GROUP" IS DEPLOYED (SWAT, DRUG TASK FORCE, ETC.) AND/OR MAKES A FORCIBLE ENTRY WITH OR WITHOUT A WARRANT.



USE OF FORCE

- Use of Force is connected to Uniform Crime Reporting program
- H.B. 84 BECAME EFFECTIVE MAY 5TH, 2021. It requires law enforcement agencies to report Use of Force data to BCI. Reporting must be done by the 16TH of each month per state statute.
- Use of Force data collection is for *transparency* but very different then an let transaction.
- REQUIREMENTS FOR USE OF FORCE
 - 1. When a fatality occurs connected to use of force by a law enforcement officer.
 - 2. When there is serious bodily injury to a person connected to use of force by a law enforcement officer.
 - 3. When a firearm is discharged by law enforcement at or in a direction of a person that did not otherwise result in death or serious bodily injury.
