
UCJIS can only be accessed using Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox










Adding Favorites (through the tree)

Common TAC Transactions

ADD – To add a new User to the agency

MUSR – To modify User information

CERT – Update User and Non-User training dates

RSPW – Reset a User's password


RU – Remove a User's access to UCJIS (before asking BCI to delete them). This transaction will not work if the account is already disabled (doesn't need to happen for non-access users or non-users)

REPT - Look at training dates, are backgrounds completed, have fingerprints been received, etc.

ACNT – Transaction counts by agency

TCNT - To view User transaction counts


When running the PREF transaction you can change things such as:

Day/Night Mode


DOB Exact or Range Data

Scenario 1:

Your agency finds a 12 year old child in the middle of the day. You want to find out if there is a missing person entry through NCIC for the child. The child is hesitant to give you any information (stranger danger), so you obviously don't have any big identifiers ex: date of birth, social, name, etc. How do you find out if they are listed on NCIC as missing person?

Answer:

In this scenario you would want to use the QM transaction (Query Missing).

Some identifiers you'll need to know in order to search the missing child on NCIC are:

- The age in the inquiry plus or minus 1 year will be searched
 - Remember that age must be between 00-99
- Approximate height in the inquiry plus or minus 3 inches will be searched
 - Remember that height must be between 400-711(if the child is below 4 feet put 400 since it is the minimum allowed value)
- Approximate weight in the inquiry plus or minus 10 pounds will be searched
 - Remember that weight must be a 3 digit character

Response to your QM Inquiry

NCIC will sort through your query and then it will use the score it in order to select (up to) 20 most likely records for the agency response. Than in order to confirm the hit (identification of missing person) the inquiring agency must review all of the information on the NCIC entry and contact the entering agency to confirm a hit.

You will check these NIC Numbers for possible matches to your missing individual.

What do you do if a hit isn't found?


- If your agency does not get a hit from the subject you are working with they would be entered as an unidentified person. This could be done by contacting BCI through Ofa Vaisima (385-499-1421) or Alex Martinez (385-499-5500).
- Once you contact them they will be listed as an Unidentified Person. Then if another agency enters the child there will be a cross check done with the unidentified file and you should receive a match.
- Once a match has been made both agencies will receive a \$M to notify you of a possible hit

Scenario 2:

You have an out of state agency call you to look up a detainer. What transaction can you use to pull that up?

Answer:

Unfortunately there isn't a specific transaction just for detainers so this is done alongside the wanted person lookup. This transaction is the QW (Query Wanted) transaction.



Since there is no separate transaction to query a detainer you will use the QW transaction. At the beginning of the entry UCJIS will let you know if there is a detainer on the individual being run.

Scenario 3:

An Agency in California has located a wanted person listed by your agency. A \$L from the agency in California was sent to your agency. A couple of weeks later your supervisor asks you if you put a copy of the \$L in the wanted person file.

Where can you get a copy of the (\$L) without having to contact California or the BCI?

Answer:

You would run the Broadcast Message Logs by using the BMSG transaction.

This transaction runs your entire agencies logs for the past 3 months.

If you need to get your agencies logs from further back you would need to fill out a dissemination log request form and submit it to Gina McNeil at gmcneil@utah.gov




Things you can get from a Dissemination Log Request Form

An offline search can do lots of things such as:


- Go back to the beginning of NCIC and see the records
- Get a list of all entries to any NCIC file (as well as purged entries)
- Search any file type entered in NCIC and all information pertaining to the entry


Things it cannot do:

- See who Cleared the Entry
- See who Cancelled the Entry










Message type is where you would put the type of BMSG you are looking for. In this case we would put YQ.




Scenario 4:


Court- Your supervisor comes to you and asks you to pack a warrant with as much information as you can. You are wondering what information this individual has that has been listed by other courts. What transaction could you use to find district court information?

Law Enforcement- You are tracking someone down and you need to get as much information about the person as you can. What transaction could you use to pull up as much useful information on the subject listed by the district court?

Answer:

In both scenarios you could run the CRT (Court Case Inquiry) transaction to gather more intel.





You can search by name or by case number if you have that on hand.





Once you have filled out all of the information in the query page you will be taken to the results tab if there are any. If you see your individual listed single click the name and you will get the Court Case System Details to show up.







Scenario 5:


Your agency is trying to gather information for an NCIC Entry. You are already using the drivers licence photo but it is really old and you want to add a more recent photo. What transaction could you use to find a more recent photo for your NCIC entry?

You can search OTRK (Offender tracking inquiry) to find photo results as well as other information that can be used for your entry.










Some other information you may also get from OTRK are; Alias Names, Residency, Employment, Scars/Marks/Tattoos, Gang Affiliations, Alias DOB, etc.



Scenario 6:


You are new to your agency and you are working with the sex crimes division. Your supervisor asks you to compile a current list of sex offenders in your agencies area. What transaction could you use to get this done efficiently?


You would use the QXS (Query Sex Offender) transaction to compile the most current information on your area.














Scenario 7:

You have a tourist getting booked and processed and you don't have much information on him. What transaction could you use to get as much information as you can without running different transactions?

In this scenario you can use the Multiple Transaction Inquiry (MI). This will give you a range of information stemming from both instate and out of state information.







Once you enter your ORI your list of transactions you can run will appear. You can either select "Check All' or you can select which transactions you want to run.




Scenario 8:


You pull someone over on a routine traffic stop early in the morning on a Monday and notice that the individual has a warrant. You noticed while walking up to the car that the individual has kids in the car holding backpacks so you assume he is taking them to school. You decide to release the individual and advise them to appear in court. How can you make it so the warrant shows that you stopped them?

You should add comments to the outstanding warrant. This can be done using the Statewide Warrant Management System (QSW). You will need to run the warrant search by an identifier listed below:

- Name Number
- Vehicle License Number
- Warrant Number

- Social Security
- Case Number
 - Operator License Number






If you search by name make sure to fill out the name search type for both first and last name. The system won't let you submit to the next page unless you do.















Scenario 9:

In this case you can use the SMOT transaction to get a list of available Violation Codes for your county.







