BACKGROUND OF UCR

Background on UCR: National Program

- The Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program generates reliable statistics for use in law enforcement. It provides information for anyone inquiring about criminal justice, researchers, the media, and the public. The program has been providing crime statistics since 1930.
- The UCR Program includes data from more than 18,000 city, university and college, county, state, tribal, and federal law enforcement agencies. Agencies submit their crime data either through a state UCR program or directly to the FBI's UCR Program.

State Program: Utah Code 53-10-205

- A law enforcement agency shall, for the jurisdiction of the law enforcement agency, submit crime reporting data required for the statewide uniform crime reporting system described in Section 53-10-205:
 - (a) to the bureau before the 16th day of the month after the month in which a reported crime occurs; and
 - (b) in a manner prescribed by the bureau and in compliance with the requirements of the Federal Bureau of Investigation's uniform crime reporting standards

What is NIBRS?

- National Incident Based Reporting System
- A nationwide view of crime based upon statistics
- Implemented to improve the overall quality of crime data collected by law enforcement
- Provides a common language for the various criminal statutes
 - Pop, Soda, or Coke?

What is Hate Crime

What is Hate Crime?
 A committed criminal offense motivated, in whole or in part by the offender's bias(es) against a race, religion, disability, sexual orientation, ethnicity, gender, or gender identity

Example –

A transgender woman was waiting at a bus stop when she was approached by a man. The man physically assaulted the victim, breaking her arm, and while calling her a "she-male" and other slurs. The police confirmed that the victim had been simply waiting at the bus stop and the assault was completely unprovoked.

LEOKA

- Law Enforcement Officers Killed and Assaulted
- Provides information about officers who were feloniously or accidentally killed or assaulted while performing their duties
- The information is published and used to help agencies develop polices to improve officer safety
- Please be sure to ask your vendor to see if your LEOKA is being submitted monthly within your NIBRS file

Use of Force

- Use of Force data is collected when force used on a subject by a law enforcement officer results in one of the following:
 - Death
 - Serious Bodily Injury
 - Discharge of a firearm at or in the direction of a person

Use of Force

- Offers big-picture insights, rather than information on specific incidents. The collection does not assess or report whether officers followed their department's policy or acted lawfully.
- With LEOKA, provides a better understanding
- As of May 5th, 2021 all law enforcement agencies are <u>required</u> to submit Use of Force data
 - Submitted through UCJIS

 - An agency switching vendors







Upload NIBRS File

- Start with your ORI, including the UT, then a period followed by the tape date year and tape date month





USE OF FORCE REPORTING

Use of Force

- What is it?
 - A collection of data that provides nationwide statistics on law enforcements incidents involving use of force
- What information does it collect?
 - Data collection includes: circumstances, subject information, officer involved information
- Is it mandatory?
 - YES! Reporting must be done by the 16th of each month in UCJIS

Requirements

- 1. When a **fatality** occurs connected to use of force by a law enforcement officer.
- When there is serious bodily injury to a person connected to use force by a law enforcement officer.
- 3. When a **firearm is discharged** by law enforcement at or in the direction of a person that did not otherwise result in death or serious bodily injury.







The definition of serious bodily injury will be based, in part, upon Title 18 United States Code (U.S.C), Section 2246 (4): The term serious bodily injury means bodily injury that involves a substantial risk of death, unconsciousness, protracted and obvious disfigurement, or protracted loss or impairment of the function of a bodily member, organ, or mental faculty. Serious bodily injury would include all gunshot wounds (regardless of whether they are penetrating or grazing), apparent broken bones, possible internal injury, severe laceration, stitches, sutures, chipped teeth, loss of teeth, canine bites requiring medical attention, unconsciousness due to an applied carotid artery hold, and injuries severe enough to require medical intervention and/or hospitalization. The term "medical intervention" does not include routine evaluation of the subject to determine fitness for arrest or detention by an emergency medical technician or medical staff at a medical facility.







UOFR – Use of Force Incident Report Query

UOFX – Use of Force Zero Report Query


