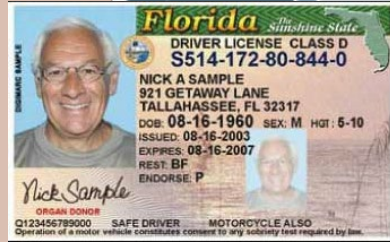

How Does Nlets Work?

- Nlets is the International Justice and Public Safety Network. It is a not-for-profit computer-based message switching system that links together and supports every state, local, and federal law enforcement, justice, and public safety agency for the purposes of sharing and exchanging critical information
- Conforms to the strictest states policies and laws

Miscellaneous Information

- Destination code of Z1 will result in an inquiry being directed to all states
This will send a separate response for each state
Will send to all 53 destinations in the Z1 list
Can be used for DL, Vehicle, and Boat inquiries
- Destination code of NL will result in the inquiry being directed to all states and will send a single response for all states
This is a consolidated response that includes statewide warrants, wildlife, sex offender, drivers license, vehicle registration and criminal history

Miscellaneous Information

- Canada does not have NIC numbers and they no longer use NCIC
- When sending a YQ to Canada, you will put “NONE” in the NIC number field
- NCIC query transactions will have a reminder at the top of the page on where to go to run that file type for Canada

Vehicle Query

Canadian information is no longer available via NCIC. Please use transaction code VQM to perform an Nlets Canadian vehicle query.

Canadian Wanted/Missing Person File Response

- Response will be either a hit or a no record response
- All hits must be handled as any other hits
- When sending a YQ to Canada, “NONE” must be inserted in the NIC field

Canadian Criminal History Inquiry

- Only agencies that are allowed access to Triple I are allowed access to the Canadian criminal history file
- There are some differences in the formats between CN and US
- Canada's unique number assigned to an individual based on fingerprints is the "FPS" number
- Canada has an optional field to access additional records when multiple hits on name inquiries are received
- The destination is always "CN"

- CPIC will return the three records that achieved the highest score
- Once identification records have been returned, the user can submit a CFQ in order to retrieve the full criminal record
- Some records cannot be disseminated outside of Canada. If you request the full record and it cannot be disseminated the message will state *“The record matching the FPS number submitted contains only information that cannot be disseminated outside of Canada”*

Canadian Drivers License Response

- Two types of responses will be received
Person file and province/territory
- If you send a query to an automated province the response will include a person file check and check of the Province's driver license file
- If you send a query to a non-automated province or territory the response will include a person file check and a message indicating that the province is non automated and if information other than status is needed, send an AM message directly to the province or territory as well as a copy of the inquiry that was sent

 - (Is the person/property in sight of the officer actually making or requesting the information)

Canadian Vehicle Registration Response

- Quebec, Ontario, Alberta, BC, Saskatchewan, and New Brunswick are the only six provinces in Canada that house their automated vehicle registration files
- All others are automated by CPIC
- The response to a province or territory will consist of a check on the CPIC vehicle file and a vehicle registration check from CPIC or directly from one of the six provinces listed above

Administrative Messages

- AM Message may be sent up to five destinations on the CPIC network
- Messages must include:
 - Reason for the request
 - Name of the Requestor
- These messages will generally be for investigative reasons of a broad nature, to request driver license information from non-automated provinces or to send broadcast messages of international interest

Administrative Messages

- To broadcast an "AM" message, it must be addressed to "CN" for a country-wide broadcast
- Only narrative messages dealing with urgent operational police matters will be considered for nationwide broadcast in Canada
- Canada has NO facility for broadcasting messages to individual provinces therefore "AM" messages to 2 character province or territory should not be sent. These will be reviewed by INTERPOL in the U.S. prior to forwarding to Canada

- A license status inquiry to theeLicenciais made by addressing the DQ or KQ message to the destination address of "MX"

- Name and date of birth inquiries are not currently supported, but are anticipated in the future

- If the vehicle is commercial and you receive a "not on file", it is not registered and is in violation of USDOT operating authority. Queries can be run by license plate only
