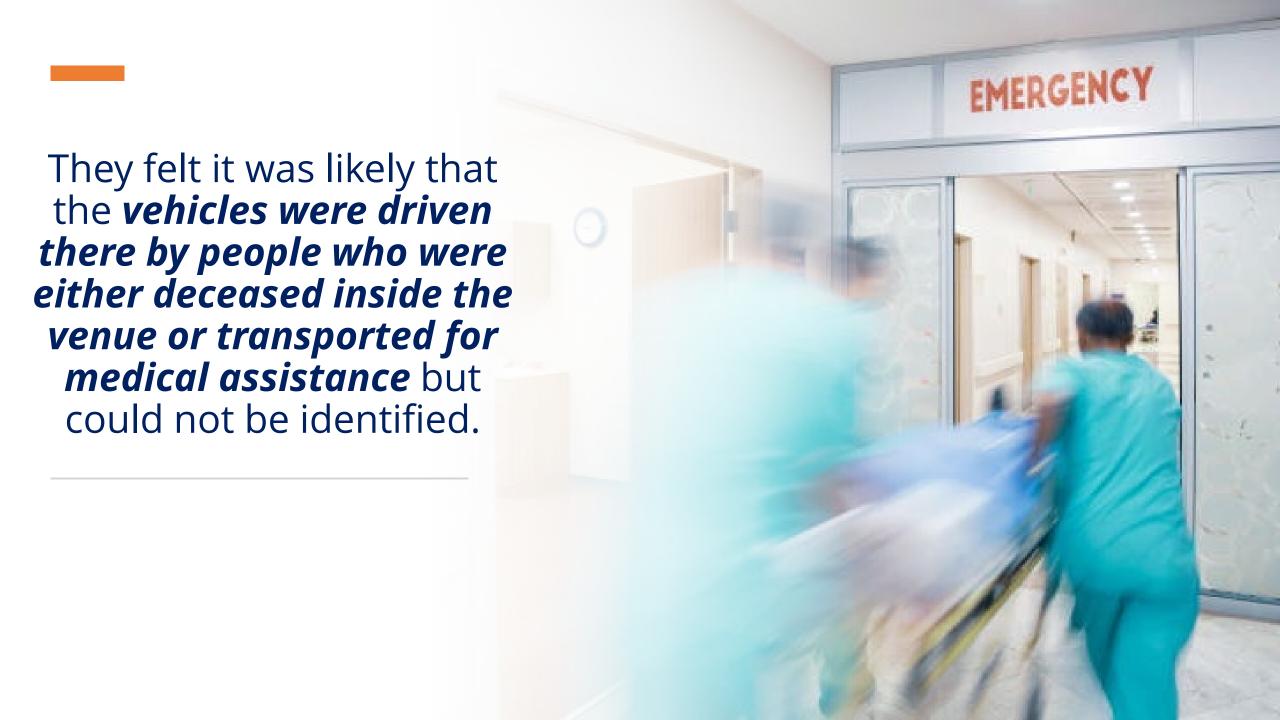
The shooting took place at night in an area where you would expect the vehicles that were parked nearby belonged to the people at the nightclub.

Police Interviewed Apalachee High School Shooting Suspect in 2023

The FBI confirmed Wednesday night that the suspected shooter and his father were interviewed by law enforcement last year in connection with threats of a school shooting posted online, according to the NY Times.

In May 2023, the FBI's National Threat Operations Center received several anonymous tips about online threats to commit a school shooting at an unidentified location and time," the FBI wrote on X. "Within 24 hours, the FBI determined the online post originated in Georgia and the FBI's Atlanta Field Office referred the information to the Jackson County Sheriff's Office for action."

The father told investigators he had number guns in the nouse but that his son did not have unsupervised access to them. Officials said the teen used an "AR-platform-style weapon" during the attack. The teen denied making threats online. The Jackson County Sheriff's Office subsequently alerted schools in the area about "monitoring" the teen but said there was no probable cause for arrest.

Success Story

- Subject approached three girls outside a library in Wyoming.
- Asked for help looking for his lost dog.
- One girl offered to help, but when she changed her mind, the man pointed a gun at her chest and made her get into his white SUV.
- The 10-year-old girl's friends reported the incident to police.

- Tied her hands behind her back with yellow rope.
- Hit her in the back of the head with a gun.
- The man later pulled off a road in Yellowstone National Park.
- He assaulted her after putting a cloth bag over her head.
- He removed the ropes and released her, where she was later found on a mountain road by hunters.
- The girl provided police a detailed description of her abductor and his vehicle, **a white SUV**.





 Video surveillance in Yellowstone National Park captured the <u>vehicle's license</u> <u>plate</u>, linking it to the suspect.

• Check of Montana DMV resulted in **outdated information**.

A check of the Fish, Wildlife, & Parks automated license system (ALS) produced a hit, which provided current address information – led to the safe arrest of the suspect.

 Suspect was convicted of four felonies and sentenced to life in prison plus 30 to 50 years.







Concealed Weapons Permit Information

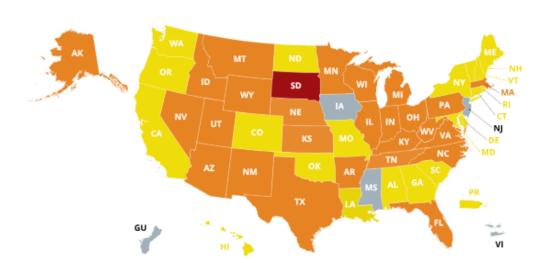

Success Story

A detective was assigned to investigate the *violation of a* domestic violence restraining order where the victim claimed her estranged boyfriend drove by her house and pointed a handgun at her to scare her from testifying against him at an upcoming court hearing.



The suspect claimed he did not own or have access to a firearm and had no familiarity with them. He said he was merely driving by her house to make sure she was okay.



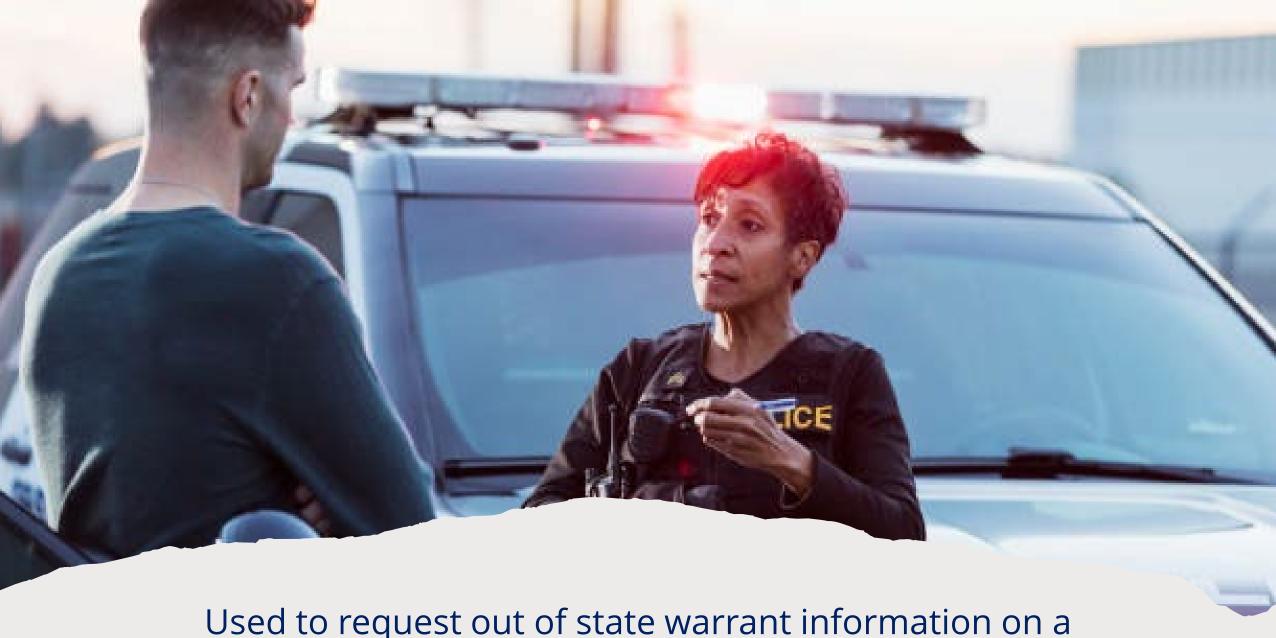
A CWQ was run - the *suspect had a permit to carry a firearm* in a neighboring state where he was now living, which undermined his earlier statement and his credibility.

The suspect was subsequently found in contempt and *convicted of aggravated assault*.

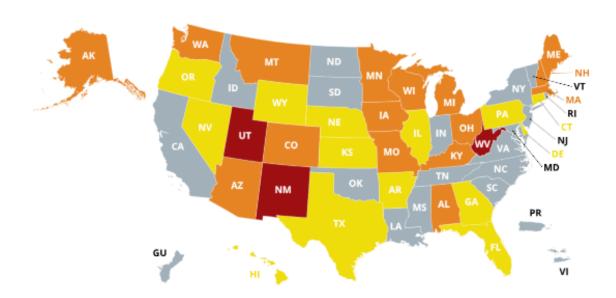

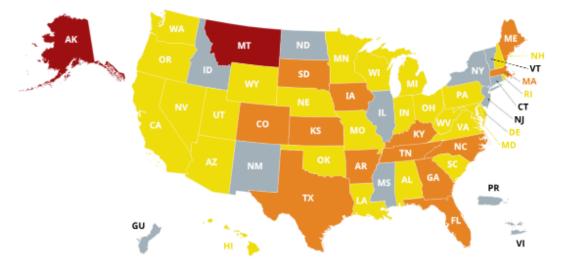

While talking to the driver, the officer notices that there are school aged children in the backseat of the vehicle.

The children do not resemble the driver and **seem to be upset**. One of the children looks as if he has been crying.

Additionally, the *driver is*pointedly avoiding eye contact

with the officer.





When the officer asks where they are headed, the driver says *he is just helping* while their parents are busy and that he is good friends with the parents.

The totality of circumstances causes the officer to suspect that they driver may not be telling the truth about his relationship with the children or their parents.

She asks dispatch to run the SOQ to see if he is a registered sex offender.

Because the sex offender query supports the consolidated response service, dispatch run the SOQ this way.

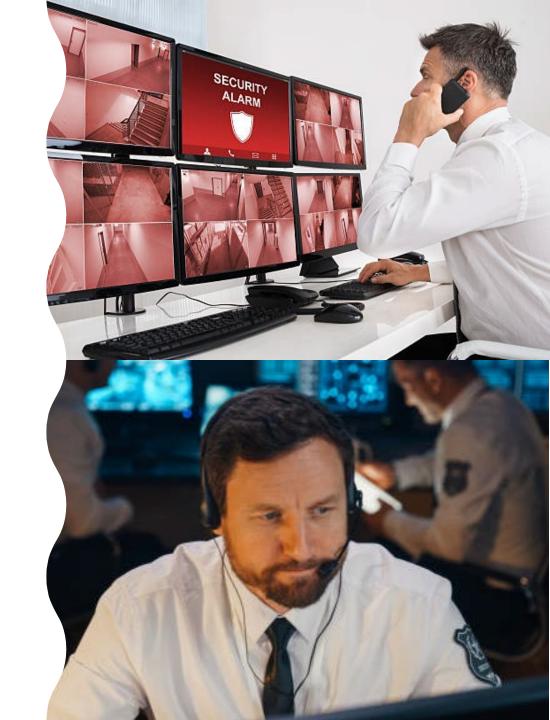
The response indicates the driver is a registered sex offender in two states, with a history of sexual assaults on minors, which leads the officer to take him in for further questioning.





Alarm Exchange / ASAP to PSAP

Provides a standard message key for *electronically transmitting information* between and alarm monitoring company and a Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP).



There are <u>three</u> primary uses for this transaction:

- *Initial notification* of an alarm event
- Bi-directional update of status between an alarm monitoring company and the PSAP
- Bi-directional update of other events between and alarm monitoring company and a PSAP.

Success Story

ADT initiated an Nlets ALQ alarm message to the **city of Richmond, VA** via the ASAP service.

The type of alarm was indicated to be holdup/panic/duress/emergency at a medical office pharmacy.







The notes in the call-for-service indicate that a male with a mask and a gun was demanding Oxycodone from the pharmacy technician







Because the alarm bypassed the call-taking process and delivered quickly via Nlets and the state of Virginia, <u>the alarm was immediately displayed for the police radio operator</u> in control of the Richmond Police Third Precinct radio console and subsequently **dispatched police units** at 11:54:46 a.m.

(26 seconds after alarm initiated)





The result was the male subject was apprehended and the primary police unit assigned cleared from the call for service with a disposition of felony arrest.

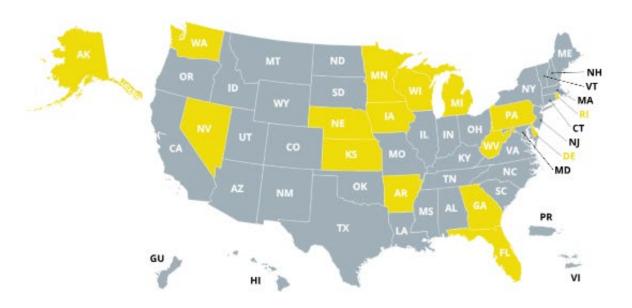

Success Story

As part of an undercover sting operation, an individual is suspected of stealing vehicles in Texas and driving them to Las Vegas to sell.

While conducting surveillance, he is observed attempting to sell a Ford F-150 that is believed to be stolen from Texas to an unsuspecting buyer.



As you may know, it is common practice for thieves to switch the VIN plate from stolen vehicles to avoid detection.

Detectives involved in the undercover operation utilize the VIN Check transaction and learn that the VIN plate affixed to the Ford F-150 belonged to a Ford Ranger.

The investigation ultimately confirmed that Smith had been engaging in online private party sales with Nevada residents using vehicles he had stolen, and the VIN plates being switched to avoid detection.



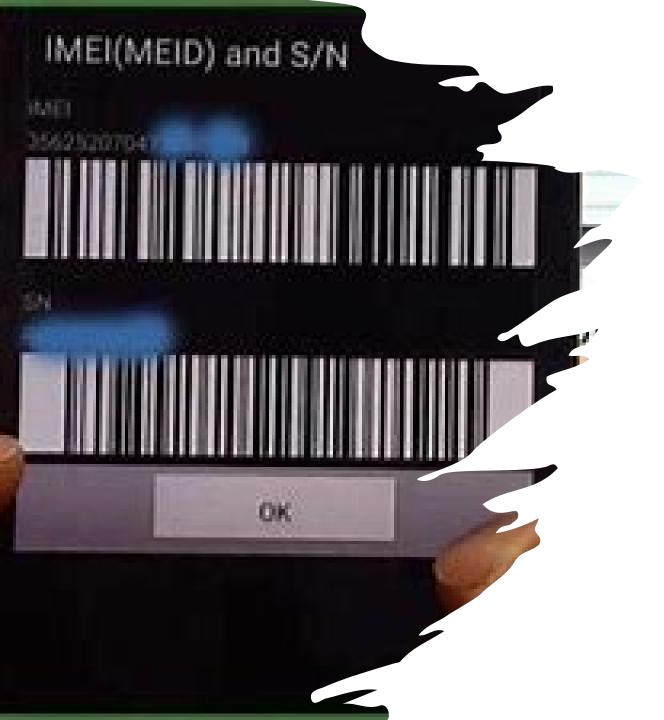


Thanks in part to the VIN Check, Smith was later booked into the Clark County Detention Center (Nevada) for:

- Possession/transfer of a stolen vehicle
- Intent to utter fictitious bill/note
- Obtaining money under false presentences



Mobile Device Query



Leverages the Recipero National Mobile Property Registery (NMPR) search, which returns **status** and **history information** about a mobile device based on its IMEI number.



<u>IMEI</u>

(International Mobile Equipment Identity)

A 14-digit number that serves as a distinct identifier for the device assigned by the manufacturer, which is guaranteed to be globally unique.

You can think of it as your phone's social security number.



The NMPR will give results showing if the IMEI has been *flagged as lost or stolen*.

It will also alert the officers or analysts if anyone has attempted or was successful in selling the device to a secondhand purchaser that reports to the NMPR all their purchases.

Every time that an attempted sale or a confirmed sale is checked against the Recipero database, *a record of this search is kept* and is shown on all future law enforcement NMPR queries.





Cell phone buy back machines capture extremely high-quality pictures of the individuals that are attempting to sell these devices.

Law enforcement is then be able to approach the company and get *actual photos* of the subject.

This is <u>hugely</u> important for investigations!





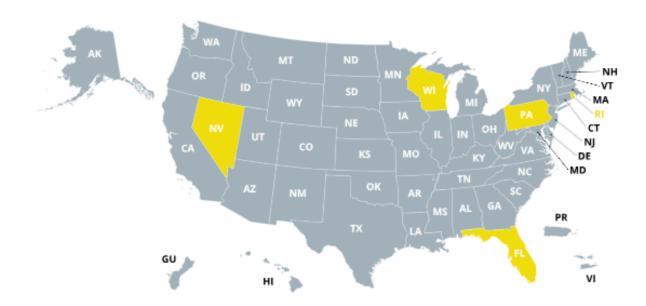

Case #1

Police were investigating a crime scene where several suspects admitted to be students at the local college.

They were charged with distributing narcotics to other students on campus.



During the investigation, police discovered multiple high-end mobile phones.

Suspecting the phones might be involved in the illegal activity, the investigating officer wants to check to see if the phones are stolen or had a history of inquiry from other jurisdictions, so he gathered the IMEI numbers from the phones and sent MDQ messages to Nlets.



The responses revealed the phones were all recently reported stolen from a local retailer, allowing investigators to link the suspects to the theft and add robbery to their charges.

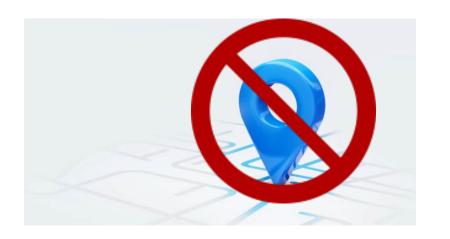


Case #2 Missing Person/Abduction

Young girl groomed online and encouraged to meet in person.

She was abducted at the first meet up.

Police had obtained her IMEI from the phone network.



Her cell phone had been shut off so no intel could be gathered on its current location.

Law enforcement put a flag (AssetWatch) alert on the IMEI.

36-hours later someone tried to sell the phone at a secondhand dealer.

Recipero's <u>system indicated a red flag</u> alert to the dealer, so they denied the transaction.

An <u>alert was instantly sent to the police</u> of the attempt to sell the phone.

Local <u>police obtained a video from the dealer</u> showing the individual attempting to sell the phone.

He was a known registered sex offender, so they went to his home address, arrested him, and recued the young girl.

Overview

The purpose of the Alarm Exchange Transaction is to help provide a standard message key for electronically transmitting information between an Alarm Monitoring Company and a Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP). There are three primary uses for this transaction:

- · Initial notification of an alarm event
- Bi-directional update of status between an alarm monitoring company and the PSAP
- Bi-directional update of other events between an alarm monitoring company and a PSAP.

This message key and its schema/format is endorsed by the Central Station Alarm Association (CSAA) as the standard for data exchange between alarm monitoring stations and PSAPs.

The standardization of this message is maintained by The Association of Public-Safety Communications Officials (APCO) and Central Station Alarm Association (CSAA). Additional documentation on this message key can be found at http://niem.gtri.gatech.edu/niemtools/iepdt/display/container.iepd?ref=Ow8gz1PI7b4#. Because of the unique requirement to provide the standardized XML to/from PSAPs even through legacy switches, Nlets will not edit the payload and instead treats the embedded APCO XML as a text string.
